Services

Skills/Interests Inventory - When students understand their own individual interests, skills, and abilities, they are more likely to make decisions that positively impact their future. After identifying this information via the Strong Interest Inventory© by Myers-Briggs, we consider how to best utilize the findings in both the high school and college context.

will evaluate you. These choices are also important in ensuring your academic record reflects both a challenging curriculum <u>and</u> successful grades. We will look at what your school has to offer and consider the best fit for the individual student.

We will take a look at all the tasks ahead of us from start to finish and space it all out so that the work is manageable. By incorporating your school calendar into this, we avoid academic pinch-points and eliminate unnecessary conflict. The goal is to maximize opportunity, not stress.
